

Eurasian Jay Jell-O Jigglers

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The Eurasian Jay can most easily be seen while in flight. The bird is known for having broad wings, and its flight is slow and appears to be somewhat erratic and weak. The way Jell-O jiggles is similar to the non-predictable flight of the Eurasian Jay.

Ingredients:

- 2 lg. pkgs. Jell-O
- 2 ½ c. boiling water

Directions:

1. Mix the two packages of Jell-O and the 2 ½ c of boiling water together.
2. Pour into 9" x 13" pan.
3. Refrigerate for 3 hours or until Jell-O is firm.
4. Once Jell-O is firm, dip bottom of pan in warm water for 15 seconds to loosen gelatin.
5. Cut shapes with cookie cutters all the way through gelatin. Lift with index finger or metal spatula. If jigglers stick, dip pan in warm water again for a few seconds.

Serves: 24 Jigglers
